



# CURBSIDE RECYCLING




## What can I recycle?


**Aluminum Beverage Cans** – No steel cans accepted at this time.

**Glass** – Glass should be separated by color; brown, green and clear. Please rinse food waste and remove all metal or plastic lids and caps from jars and bottles. No plate glass, light bulbs, ceramics or other glassware accepted.

**Paper** – All types of paper to include magazines, phone books, catalogues and flattened cardboard. Wax Paper, aluminum foil, soap boxes, pizza boxes, tissue or paper that has been laminated in plastic cannot be recycled

**Plastics** – All rigid plastic containers with the exception of motor oil, styrofoam and grocery bags are to be recycled.

**PETE**  plastic is to be separated from all other plastics. This type plastic is found in clear and green plastic drink bottles.

Since the ban of plastics at the Wayne County Landfill on October 1, 2009, all other plastics are to be grouped with **HDPE**  plastic.

## Do I Have to Participate?

**YES.** The City pays approximately \$300,000.00 per year in landfill fees and fines for having recyclable items in our landfill loads. You must have your recycle container to the curb at least once per month or be fined \$25.00 on your utility bill.

**PLEASE RECYCLE – IT'S A MUCH CHEAPER ALTERNATIVE TO THE LANDFILL. HELP KEEP OUR TAXES LOW!**
